Supplementary bills, issued after renovations or additions, are mailed July through December.

Lakeshore Signs Community Support Agreement with Hydro One

The Municipality of Lakeshore will benefit from \$8 million in new local investments, including \$5.8 million to directly support culture and recreation projects as a result of a new Community Support Agreement signed between Hydro One and Lakeshore.

Washroom facilities at public parks are slated to close on Friday, October 6, 2023.

Free WiFi Coming to Lakeshore Parks!

Free public WiFi Internet service will be available at a number of Lakeshore parks after Council agreed to provide a Letter of Support to Gosfield North Communications at the Regular Meeting on Tuesday, August 15. The service will be a significant step towards enhancing digital connectivity for residents and visitors.



The project will see WiFi services available at: Optimist Park, Ladouceur/ Lions Park, Duck Creek Park, Lakeview Park, Millen Park, and Comber Community Centre.

WiFi services are expected to be available by mid-2024.
